Programs such as Saxon Phonics, iReady Reading, and Envision are utilized to enhance instruction and provide a strong foundation of literacy and number sense. Additionally, students experience hands-on learning in the school's STEAM lab and in the school's garden.

Technology is utilized in every classroom. Teachers and students have access to an Interactive Promethean Board, document cameras, and every child is provided with a laptop to enhance instruction.
