The faculty at Factory Shoals Middle School has one main goal: to teach and guide their students so that they may learn, grow, and become productive members of society. Teachers aim to create Learning Focused School lessons that allow for student choice, collaboration, and hands-on activities that will engage students and encourage them to utilize their higher order thinking skills. In addition, teachers encourage students to think out of the box in all subject areas. All departments and teams collaborate vertically and horizontally to analyze data and plan lessons that will support improvement for all students.

The Reading and Language Arts departments intentionally focus on developing powerful readers and writers. They aim to make reading an exciting experience by engaging their students through the use of novels of varying genres and topics that help them to build on prior knowledge, improve vocabulary skills, as well as expose them to new ideas and technology. Students learn and create cross-curricular writings using mentor texts and relevant topics that relate to concepts taught in math, science, and social studies classes.
