Beyond the Classroom

Yeager Middle School diligently works to teach to the “whole” child by making all students feel valued. Every morning during the announcements, YMS students acknowledge pride in their country first, and then their school through the Mustang Pledge. YMS teaches students to take pride in their school *and* community by participating in Pink-Out Days to support cancer awareness, Pennies for Patients, Pennies for PAWS, and numerous food drives. Yeager continuously rewards excellence in all areas by acknowledging honor roll students every nine weeks and giving numerous incentives for positive behavior. Teachers give out Y.E.S tickets (Yeager’s Exceptional Students) or positive referrals to students for doing great things for their peers, their teachers, or around the school. Every nine weeks, they “cash in” these points at the Mustang Market AND participate in a party!

After the school day is over, several students attend the 21st Century Focus After School Program. This program provides homework assistance, extra remediation, and recreation time. After school activities are available to all students; however, for students that cannot stay after school, Yeager has established Blue Day. Once a month, students take the first 40 minutes of the school day to enjoy a club of their choice based on something they love! Students are able to explore their interests through Art Club, Math Club, Road Runners, Junior Beta, Student Council, Tome Reading Team, Yeager Movie Appreciation, Band, Anime Club, Chorus, Fellowship of Christian Athletes (FCA), Relay for Life, and many more.
